NARRATIVE:

THIS UNIT AND UNIT 5836 TECHNICIAN F. SANDERS WAS REQUESTED TO RESPOND TO THE ABOVE LOCATION TO PROCESS THE SCENE OF A SUSPICIOUS DEATH. UPON THIS UNITS ARRIVAL, THERE 19 CARTRIDGE CASINGS, OBSERVED IN THE ROADWAY AS WELL AS A ROLLED CONDOM. ALSO ALONG THE ROADSIDE WAS A CONDOM WRAPPER AND TWO BLOCKBUSTER VIDEO CASES. THE REMAINS OF WHAT APPEARED TO A HUMAN BODY WAS OBSERVED APPROXIMATELY 114 FEET NORTH OF THE ROADWAY IN THE 4400 BUS OF FRANKLIN RD. PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE SCENE WERE TAKEN, AS WELL AS BEING VIDEO TAPED AND SKETCHED. WILLIAM C. RODRIGUEZ III, P.A.D (CHIEF DEPUTY MEDICAL EXAMINER) AND GRANT D GRAHAM SR., M.F.S (CHIEF, FORENSIC TRACE MATERIALS ANALYSIS LABORATORY) FROM THE OFFICE OF THE ARMED FORCES MEDICAL EXAMINER ALSO RESPONDED TO THE SCENE TO ASSIST IN EXCAVATING THE BODY. A UV SOURCE WAS USED AT THE SCENE ON THE BODY TO DETECT ANY FOREIGN MATERIALS ON OR AROUND THE BODY WITH POSITIVE RESULTS (* SEE AC#99004535). TIRE IMPRESSIONS WERE ALSO OBSERVED AT THE SCENE, WHICH A PLASTER CAST WAS MADE OF, AND SUBMITTED TO PCW.

4	Narrative:	This unit and unit 5836 Technician F Sanders was requested to respond to the above location to process the scene of a suspicious death.
4	Narrative:	Upon this unit's arrival there, there [were] 19 cartridge casings observed in the roadway as well as a rolled condom.
4	Narrative:	Also along the roadside was a condom wrapper and two blockbuster video cases.
4	Narrative:	The remains of what appeared to a human body was observed approximately 114 feet north of the roadway in the 4400 blk of Franklinton Rd. Photographs of the scene were taken, as well as being video taped and sketched
4	Narrative:	William C. Rodriguez III (Chief, Deputy Medical Examiner) and Grant D Graham SR, MFS (Chief, Forensic Trace Materials Analysis Laboratory) from the Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner also responded to the scene to assist in excavating the body.
4	Narrative:	A UV source was used at the scene on the body to detect any foreign materials on or around the body with positive results (se AC#9004535).
4	Narrative:	Tire impressions were also observed at the scene which a plaster case was made of and submitted to ECU.
