On 02/01/99 the assigned met Mr. Kim at his store on Pennsylvania Avenue. Mr. Kim said the family was concerned and reported Hae's disappearance when she failed to pick up her cousin from Campfield Day Care Center. Mr. Kim said Hae has never done anything like this before and they were very worried.

Mr. Kim said the only problem Hae had at home was an argument with her mother on 01/03/99. Hae was out with Donald and did not come home until 0100 hours. The argument ended that day and Hae did not appear to be bothered by it.

Mr. Kim said Hae has a bank account with Nations Bank and a Nations Bank Visa card. The assigned contacted Mr. Ben Henry, Nations Bank investigator, and provided Hae's account information. Mr. Henry said there was no activity on either account since 01/12/99.
