From BPD to AT&T with the "13 cell sites" subpoena.**

This fax is page 1385 of the MPIA 15 459 file, the next two pages show a subpoena which was served on AT&T, it seems, using that fax cover sheet.

The subpoena itself is already on the wiki, see p1 and 2 ONLY of this file:

The subpoena asked AT&T for "*the name(s) addresse(s) for the following telephone number and (13) cell site locations, from January 1, 1999 to present*" but although Adnan's number is then listed, the 13 cell sites are not. So what cell sites did they mean?

[Susan Simpson](#), of [Undisclosed Podcast](#), noticed that there are also 13 cell sites used by Adnan's phone on January 13, according to the AT&T records used at trial. But, according to the Baltimore PD's own files, they did not receive any cell site data from AT&T until February 22, at least six days after the subpoena was written.
